

Co-curricular next half term

The choices for co-curricular next half term are now live on CHQ. Please encourage your son to log on to his CHQ account to make his preferences. Boys should select 1 for the club they would most like and try working up to at least number 12 in the week. They cannot repeat a number in the whole week.

You may see that your son has already been placed in a session, this is designed to support his studies or development at FBS. The focus for this term is support and challenge, in the summer term the focus





will return to enterprise and interest and the boys will have a much freer choice. Please support us by explaining to your son how beneficial it will be for him to take, for example, 'English comparison skills'.

If your son is experiencing any trouble logging on to CHQ or making his selections please ask him to speak to his form teacher or email Ms Johnson s.johnson@fulhamboysschool.org.uk.

The selections process closes on Wednesday 7th February at 8pm and all boys will be emailed their allocations on Thursday so that the co-curricular can start when we are back from half term on Tuesday 20th February. Please encourage your son to check what he has been allocated by logging back on to CHQ so that he comes back to school with the correct equipment for clubs.

Lockdown Procedure

The school has developed a new lockdown procedure for use in the highly unlikely event of a serious incident developing on site. Many other schools have introduced similar procedures in recent years. Boys will have this procedure explained to them by their tutors during PSHCE on Tuesday morning.

Year 9 Options Evening

It is really important that parents and boys in Year 9 attend this Options Evening. These are the most important decisions your son has been asked to make so far in his school career, as the choices he makes now will have an impact on his future possibilities.
