Uniform and Appearance

As we are coming to the end of term I would like to take the opportunity to remind you all about uniform and appearance for next year.

- All boys need to buy house ties as well as their school tie. Boys will be required to wear their house tie on certain occasions, which they will be informed of in advance.
- Year 10 boys must buy an upper school tie and wear it to school daily.

Most importantly can I remind you of the school's policy regarding hair styles. Hair styles should be tidy and of a conventional nature, no extreme or 'cult' haircuts including sculpting, shaving, dreadlocks or braiding are allowed. The maximum hair length is above the collar and the minimum hair length is a number 2 cut. Hair must be one natural colour. Parents are strongly advised to seek advice on the acceptability of hairstyles that may be considered 'different' before allowing their son to adopt such a style. School reserves the right to insist on re-styling if it considers the style inappropriate. Boys coming to school with hair that goes against the school policy will be excluded from school for one day.

As we have said repeatedly, high standards and firm discipline are extremely important at FBS and we are determined to uphold these standards.


