## Enterprise Week 2018 – Message from Mr Maddison

With so many events going on and boys all over London (supervised and registered as always) it has been necessary to have boys record their own timetable. Please ask your son to share with you the video and accompanying documentation as well as the timetable he has created on his Google Classroom for Enterprise Week 2018. All activities are explained, as well as staffing, rooming and equipment required. Parents and guardians have received a permission form that must be returned electronically or physically in order for him to partake in all activities. Boys will require their bags, planner, pencil case, conduct card and Chromebook each day.

There will be some edible goods created and sold by boys throughout the week to raise money for youth homelessness charity DePaul and so it would be appropriate for boys to have a pound or two to buy these products if you wish to support this cause. It goes without saying that we expect boys to have an incredible time while not dropping their standards for a moment. Conduct cards and existing rewards and sanctions procedures will continue to be in force throughout the week - the day will finish earlier than usual. Afternoon registration will take place at 3.10pm

Each day, students on site (many Year 10's have organised and obtained parental permission for work experience) will complete a reflective journal. Please do ask your son to show you his reflections each day and talk about these. There is a great deal of time and effort from all staff and visitors to help boys to become more enterprising and this really has an impact when boys reflect upon their thoughts and experiences with you.


