Year 10 Parent Consultation - Thursday 15th October

A reminder that Year 10 Parent Consultation is happening on Thursday 15th October. We have worked hard to ensure the afternoon can run in a COVID friendly socially distanced way. Appointments should be made on the CHQ booking system and we hope that all parents will be able to attend along with their sons as we work together to support all boys in achieving their potential.

Year 7 PSHCE afternoon - Thursday 15th October

During Year 10 Parent Consultation, Year 7 boys will have a PSHCE afternoon consisting of three sessions on equality, specifically addressing racist, homophobic and sexist language and behaviours. Boys will have lessons during Period 5 as normal and will then go to Gibbs Green Hall at 2.30pm. The session will finish at 4.15pm and boys will be dismissed from Gibbs Green.

Year 11 Parent Consultation - Wednesday 4th November

The first subject teacher parent consultation day of Year 11 is happening on Wednesday 4th November. This is an opportunity for all parents or guardians of Year 11 boys to meet with their son's subject teachers to discuss progress in Year 11, including the recent first round of mock exams. Year 11 reports outlining these results will be published on Parent Portal on Friday 16th October. It is essential that all parents have read these reports before attending Parent Consultation. Assessments for all year groups

All boys should have completed an in-class assessment in all their subjects by the end of this half term (Year 11 have had a full week of mock exams). These assessments give us a good indication of where each boy is at and what he needs to work on before their exam week (see dates below). Formal school

reports will be published after each exam point but in the meantime please discuss your son's in-class assessments with him including how far he is from reaching his End of Year Target Grade and look through his books for feedback from the teachers to support his progress.
