Dyslexia Event for Parents Monday 18th November 6-8pm

On Monday 18th November from 6pm to 8pm there will be a film screening of 'The Big Picture: Rethinking Dyslexia' followed by Q&A with a specialist panel.

This film provides personal and uplifting accounts of the dyslexic experience from children, experts and iconic leaders, such as Sir Richard Branson and financier Charles Schwab. Directed by James Redford, the film not only addresses misconceptions about dyslexia, but paints a picture of hope for

all who struggle with it. In looking at dyslexia as a neurological issue and not a character flaw, The Big Picture beautifully illustrates that while this challenge may be an obstacle in school, it also carries some unique advantages that, once it is understood, can be a source of great strength in later life.
